The IQAC coordinator presented a brief report submitted to the NAAC before the members. The report was presented according to the criteria of the NAAC.

- Criteria 7 : Institutional values and best practices.


Based on the presentation, the following suggestions were put forth by the members :

Dr Anandi Martis suggested that

- Identify the objectives of the cell and the expected functions.
- Prepare benchmarks by fulfilling the objectives of IQAC – align NAAC work with the functions of IQAC.
- As an institution, what is the quality culture ? In what way the college is different from other colleges?
- Measure the performances and check the range in development.
- To have a structured feedback analysis from various stakeholders.
- To prepare a training package to answer NET.
- Organize guest lecture from CTE to give awareness on government schemes, funds etc.
- To have more collaborations and take up research projects – linkage with industry such as Azim Premji foundation.

Dr Syprian Monteiro made the following remarks and suggestions

- The number of students who cleared TET, shows that the quality of the programme is high and speaks well of improvement.
- Appreciated the efforts of the institution in areas of achievement, e-library, NAAC accreditations, participation in service learning and active participation of staff.
- To have a network system where students can fill in their achievements.


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- To conduct awareness programmes on TET.
- To invite special experts for training in skill development programmes.
- Observations were made on the reduction of funds received for projects after 2019.

Fr. Robert D'Souza made the following remarks

- Record scholarships provided as one of the best practices of the institution.
- Connect objectives of the programme to the final results.

Remarks by the Dr Farita Viegas

- Align the planning of the programme to the execution and the results.
- Make a holistic report and identify the opportunities beyond these.

Mrs Jahnavi Sanal, Alumni mentioned that the B.Ed. programme as of now is training teachers to be well prepared to face the challenges of society.

The student representatives of B.Ed. and M.Ed. appreciated the quality and resources of the institution.

Taking all the above observations and suggestions, the chairperson said that these aspects will be taken care of and presented during the next meeting.


The IQAC coordinator thanked every member of the cell, both external and internal for their presence and whole hearted participation and suggestions for the betterment of the institution.
