- A one day Spiritual Orientation Programme was conducted on March 13, 2019 by Rev. Fr Pius James D'Souza, Rev. Fr Ligoury Crasta and Dr Jovel Olivera.
- The B.Ed Students attended a one day training session on 'Drug Abuse, Anti-ragging, Sexual Harassment and Environmental Protection" held at Milagres College, Mangaluru on September 30, 2019.
- With the objective of strengthening, enriching and improving the quality of individual and family life, a Seminar on Family Life Education was organized in two phases. The Resource Persons invited were Dr Jenita Pinto, Medical Microbiologist, U.A.E., Dr Jessy D'Souza Obstetrician and Gynaecologist, Fr Santhosh Rodrigues, Former Director of Family Life and Counseling Centre, Diocese of Mangalore, Bajjodi, Mrs Rosa Mathew, Assistant Professor in Counseling, Roshni Nilaya and Mrs Sharel Prabhu, Graduate Assistant, St Aloysius High School, Mangaluru. Spiritual Formation ... A Path to Understand Life

The following events enriched the spiritual direction of our students. Prayer days, Retreat, and Orientation Programmes were arranged for the spiritual and moral development of the students. Regular Value Education classes were a source of strength for our students to set an example for the future. A distinctive feature of this college is the teacher trainees taking turns to organize the Morning Assembly in an effective way.

Strengthening Academics

- To enhance the Teaching Skills of our Teacher Trainees, Micro Teaching Sessions, Demonstration Lessons using Multimedia, Simulated lessons, Integrated Lessons,
 Pre-Teaching Observation of Lessons, Workshops on Lesson Planning and Evaluation in all Pedagogy Subjects was conducted. Video Recording was one of the techniques of providing feedback.
- Theory and Practice of Lessons using Models of Teaching gave an insight to the Students in using the innovative approaches in teaching.
- To accustom the Teacher Trainees with the regular school set up, an **Internship Programme** of duration of two months was organized. All Teacher Trainees were trained to take up Action Research Projects, school based assignments and community based projects. The task based activities made the teaching learning process more experiential.



With an aim of developing creative thinking and new study techniques and approach academic situations in different arrays, a workshop on 'Drama and Art in Education' was organized.

Mr Christopher D'Souza, Lecturer in Commerce, Padua PU College and Mr Clanwin Fernanades, Graphic Designer and Theatre Artist

were the resource persons. The evaluation was followed by a stage performance comprising different activities.

 Resource Persons in various dimensions trained the teacher trainees to prepare assorted products like flower bouquets, jewelry and tussel making. This was followed by an exhibition of the products.
